Absence Communication

In order to ensure the safe arrival and handover of all pupils to school, we would ask that parents contact school, by telephone, to report a pupil's absence or sickness. We appreciate your assistance in this matter.

Sickness

To ensure the health and safety of all pupils, especially those most vulnerable, parents are asked not send pupils to school if they are acutely unwell or infectious. The advice of a GP should be sought regarding suitable periods away from school following certain illnesses and infections. Pupils should remain out of school for 48 hours after the last time they have experienced vomiting or diarrhoea. Thank you.
