There are over 42,000 people with a learning disability in Northern Ireland. Often they go under represented, are misunderstood, or struggle to have their rights respected and achievements celebrated.

Learning Disability Pride is a day to celebrate people with a learning disability and their achievements, while raising awareness and challenging stereotypes about learning disability.

The event will be hosted by Carrickfergus & District Senior Gateway Club supported by a range of organisations who work with people with a learning disability. There will be a Carnival Parade, Live Music, Entertainment, Workshops, Information / Market Stalls and family friendly accessible activities.

STATISTICS


- 100% of respondents agreed that they enjoyed themselves
